THE LEGAL ACTIONS THAT YOU CAN TAKE TO CEASE THE COUNTERFEITING ACTIVITIES IN INDONESIA

- Investigating a party who allegedly produces and/or sells counterfeit products.
 This effort may be taken if you would like to investigate the party who allegedly produces and/or sells counterfeit products in Indonesia. You may use an independent investigator to conduct this matter.
- Issuing a warning statement against counterfeiting to be announced in newspaper(s). This effort may be taken if you would like to warn the business enterprises in general in Indonesia to cease their counterfeiting activities and to announce to the public that you are the rightful owner of the original products. It would be advisable to announce this warning in newspaper(s) regularly, for example, once a year.
- Sending circular letter(s) to the traders.
 This effort may be taken if you would like to warn the traders in general in Indonesia to cease their counterfeiting activities and to announce to them that you are the rightful owner of the original products.
- Sending warning letter(s) to a party who allegedly produces and/or sells counterfeit products.
 This effort may be taken if you would like to warn the party who allegedly produces

and/or sells counterfeit products in Indonesia. If at this stage, the party who allegedly produces and/or sells counterfeit products in Indonesia obeys your requests in your warning letter, you need to make a settlement agreement between you and the party.

Reporting a party to the relevant police precinct for alleged counterfeiting crimes.
 This effort may be taken if you would like to report the party to the relevant police precinct for alleged counterfeiting crimes. Absolutely, this effort needs deep cooperation with the police since you will conduct some raids at this stage.
